The lower river is restored and meanders naturally! But more needs to be done on the upper river and the Flax Pond stream to make the river “fish friendly.” The fish still have trouble finding their way through the many remaining culverts and smaller dams.

Help us fund the 6th year of the CRT’s program to tag and follow herring. Tagging herring allows us to ‘see the river’ from their point of view — what ponds they

use for spawning, and how long they stay (or get stuck) in various sections of the River. This information allows us to target areas for restoration.
